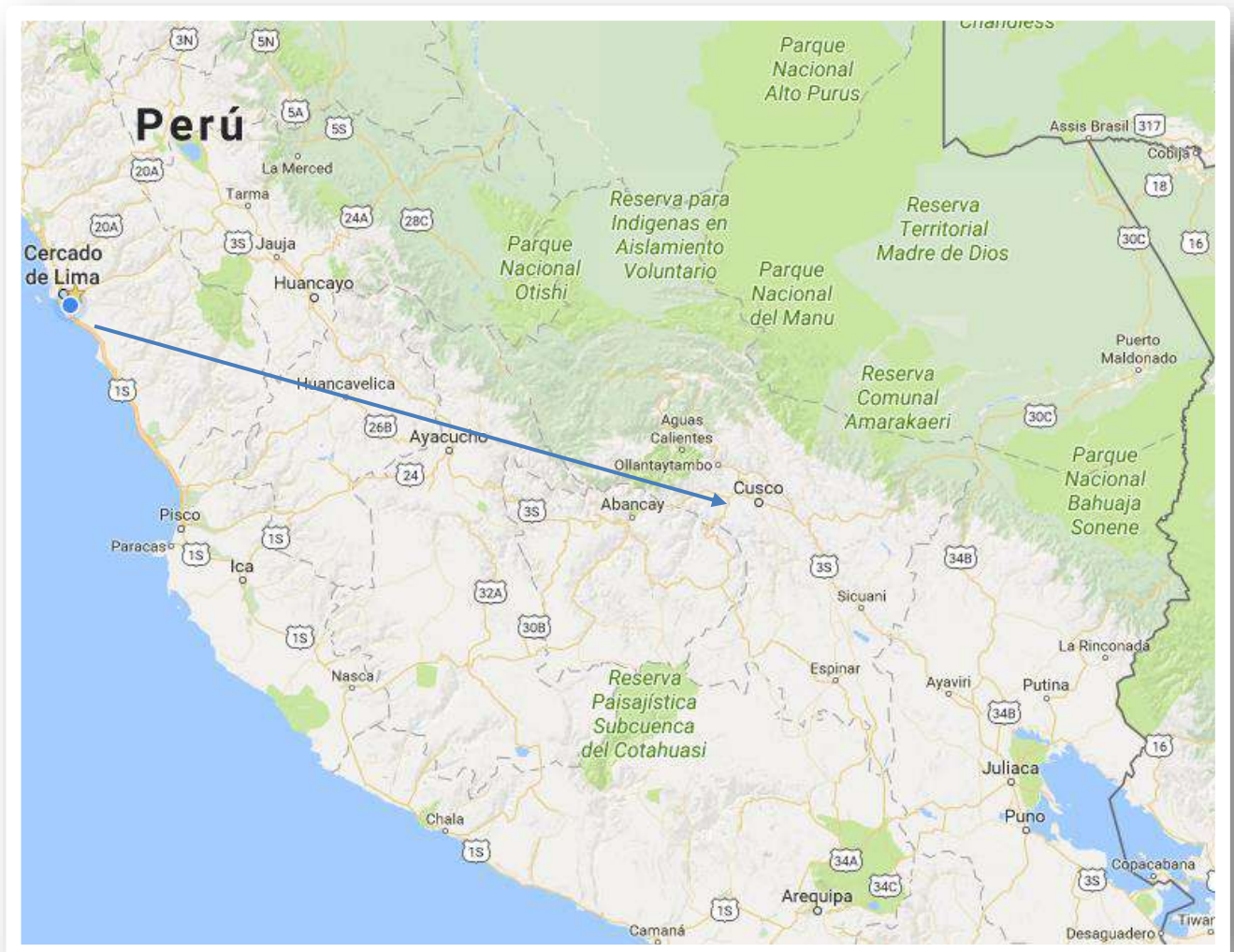
PERU: CUSCO

ITINERARY FOR 02 DAYS

Day 1. Cusco-Pisaq

Day 2. Pisaq-Urubamba-Ollantaytambo

End of the itinerary



"We will visit the Sacred Valley of the Incas, having special meetings with the inhabitants of the communities that populate the ancient Inca territories. We will learn about their artistic manifestations, learning from their traditional knowledge in Andean textile art, their designs, their natural dyes and the manufacture of contemporary ceramics, transmitted from generation to generation until today. Afterwards, we will visit the archaeological centers of Písaq and Ollantaytambo, discovering their sacred architecture".

DAY 1. CUSCO – PISAQ

Departure time: 09:00 am

Duration: 7 hours approximately

Afterwards, we will go to the Amaru community, to carry out an Andean Textile Art workshop with its inhabitants where visitors are invited to accompany the community members to the collection of flowers and leaves that will serve as inputs to make natural dyes. We will continue with the short demonstration of shearing, spinning and skein of wool; it continues with a demonstration of dyeing and fixing the color in the wool to finish the hand-weaving process. The iconography that is used in each of these fabrics is loaded with an important symbolic value for the community members of Amaru; they will tell us the meanings of some of the most important motifs. Finally, we visit the exhibition hall of the finished garments and we will be able to acquire the variety of textiles (blankets, centerpieces, scarves, scarves, Andean sweaters or bags, belts among others) at night we will enjoy a succulent dinner.

Overnight: Overnight in a rural house - Amaru Community (Písaq)

Included: Lunch and dinner with the Amaru Community

DAY 2. PISAQ-URUBAMBA-OLLANTAYTAMBO

Departure time from Písaq: 08:00 am

Duration: 8 hours approximately

Departure from the Amaru community to Urubamba town. We will make a stop at the Seminario workshop-gallery, where we will be able to appreciate contemporary ceramic pieces, based on traditional techniques. Afterwards, we will visit the Inkariy Museum, which was an initiative of archaeologists and artists to show the world the impressive manifestations of the most important cultures of Peru - Pre-Hispanic. Then we will leave for the town of Ollantaytambo where we will know its urban development and its majestic archaeological center, which is associated with Inca astronomy and architectural work in stone. In Ollantaytambo, we will be able to appreciate how the ancient Peruvians were able to move huge stones from one mountain to another.
