




TOUR: GASTRONOMY - 2 DAYS/1 NIGHT EXPERIMENTAL PROGRAM IN THE SACRED VALLEY

Day 1. Cusco-Park of potato-Huchuyqosqo Day 2. Huchuyqosqo-Urubamba-Ollantaytambo

End of itinerary



Discover prestigious archaeological sites of the Sacred Valley linked to the ancient agriculture of the Andes and then discover ingredients and culinary techniques that endure and develop from the time of the Incas to the present day.

DAY 1. CUSCO - PARQUE DE LA PAPA - HUCHUYQOSQO

Departure time: 09:00

Duration: 7 hours approximately

Departure from your Hotel to the Sacred Valley of the Incas. You will visit the community of Paru Paru, where we will meet with its residents the park of the potato. Conservation site of one of the main ingredients in Peruvian cuisine; the park integrates 5 communities, producing 820 varieties of native.

After the tour and interpretation of the potato park we will enjoy lunch in the restaurant Papamanka, which has a menu specializing in succulent potato dishes. The restaurant has a privileged view of the park and the restaurant mixes concepts of the Andean culinary tradition with the Novo-Andina. Then we will visit the town of Pisaq and its archaeological monument, which is considered one of the most important in the Sacred Valley of the Incas. This monument is associated with agronomy and the worship of the Kuntur (Condor), a sacred animal for the ancestors. At the end of the day we will head to the community of Huchuyqosqo where you will enjoy a succulent dinner. Overnight in a farmhouse - Community of Amaru Huchuyqosqo.

Overnight: Cottage of the Community of Huchuygosgo (Lamay)

Included: lunch in Papamanka Potato Park and dinner with the Community of Huchuyqosqo

DAY 2. HUCHUYQOSQO - URUBAMBA - OLLANTAYTAMBO

Departure from Huchuyqosqo towards Ollantaytambo: 09:00 am duration: 8 hours approximately

Departure from the community of Huchuyqosqo towards the village of Ollantaytambo. In Ollantaytambo we will carry out the workshop of Pachamanca, a traditional Andean dish which preserves a millennial culinary technique-based on cooking under the ground. After the explanation that you will enjoy a dish of Pachamanca, under a cool thatched roof on an organic farm, with a preferential view of the archaeological site of Ollantaytambo, as well as the glaciers of the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Pachamanca will be served with various traditional meats, tubers and grains accompanied by salads prepared with fresh vegetable garden and a variety of Andean sauces, besides the refreshing chicha morada. We will visit the town of Ollantaytambo where we will know its urban development and its majestic archaeological center which is associated with Inca astronomy and architectural work in stone. In Ollantaytambo we can see how the ancient Peruvians were able to move huge stones from one mountain to another. After the visit Transfer to coordinated point
